About Round Mountain

Round Mountain is best known for the Round Mountain Gold Mine, a large open pit heap-leach gold mine owned by Kinross Gold Corporation and Barrick Gold Corporation. The first gold production from the Round Mountain District was in 1906, and by 2006 the mine reached the significant milestone of 10 million ounces poured. The mine has recently expanded with a satellite pit 5 miles north of the existing operation.

Round Mountain is located in beautiful Smoky Valley with mountains as high as 12,000 ft. Alfalfa and cattle ranches spot the nearly 100 mile long valley and cowboys moving cattle are a common site. Camping and all outdoor recreation are what the residents and visitors do on weekends.

Round Mountain has a population of 1,577. The median age of the population is 36.7 years, with 77.3 percent (1,219) age 16 and older and 8.7 percent (137) age 65 and older. (2010 Census, Round Mountain CCD).
